

The Swann-Morton Surgical Blade Remover

Single use and available sterile in boxes of 50 it can be used within the Operating Room at the point of the procedure to remove the full range of surgical blade shapes from either a No.3 or a No.4 fitment handle. Protecting staff from sharps injuries during contaminated blade removal it is also transparent allowing for the count at the end of the procedure before disposing in an appropriate sharps container.

Skin Graft Blade (SG3)

In stainless steel, with 5cm long cutting edge. Fits a No.3 fitment handle. Sterilised, packed individually, boxed in 20's.

Cervical Biopsy Blade
In stainless steel, sterilised, supplied in single plastic trays in boxes of 10. Fits the Long and Short Swann Major Handles which can be viewed on the website along with the Swann-Major blades.

Myringotomy Blade
Long, angled, stainless steel blade with short cutting edges at tip. Purpose-designed for both up and down cutting. Individually packed, sterilised and boxed in 10's. This blade fits the 'FINE' range of handles.

'Minor' Disposables
Can be used as a component part of a "Procedure Kit". Small polystyrene handle can be supplied fitted with blade No's 10, 10A, 11, 15 or 15A. Polyethylene blade guard. Non-sterile and bulk-packed.

Sabre Disposable Scalpels
A choice of 3 'Sabre' sterile disposable scalpels – E/11, D/15 and B/23 – each supplied individually packed, boxed in 10's.

Guarded Disposable Scalpels
Available with the most popular stainless steel blade shapes, and are fitted with a polyethylene protective guard. The sterile scalpels are individually wrapped in a view pack, and boxed in units of 10. Also available in a bulk, non-sterile format. For use in custom procedure trays and kits.

Disposable Scalpels
Available with all standard stainless steel blade shapes, complete with CE marked polystyrene handles with a graduated measure (for indication only), individually sealed in a tray designed to assist with safe passing protocols, sterilized and boxed in units of 10.

Disposable Scalpels with Retractable Blade
Specially designed to assist in the reduction of potential sharps injuries this scalpel has a high visibility red handle combined with a retractable blade to support safe passing protocols. Colour coded sliders to indicate the blade shape, an audible click when engaging the usage, passing and locked positions and ribbed, slip resistant finger grips for a secure hold in a gloved hand. They are available in stainless steel blade shapes 10, 11P, 15, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25A in sterile packs of 25. Also available in non-sterile packs of 500. For use in custom procedure trays and kits.

'Fine' Blades and Handles
The 'Fine' range has small, slim, precise blades in stainless steel for delicate operations. Six special handles, including the SF13 and SF23 with independently screwed top sections to facilitate blade-changing, take all blades, supplied in individual metal foil packets, available in dispenser units of 25. Handles are supplied individually in plastic wallets.

Standard Surgical Blades and Handles – No.3 Fitment
Surgical Blade No's 6, 9, 10, 10A, 11, 11P, E/11, Sabre E/11, 12, 12D, 13, 14, 15, 15A, 15C, 15T, Sabre D/15, 16, 40 fit No's 3, 3L, 5, 7, 9, B3 & B3L handles.

All handles are available in Stainless Steel, individually wrapped, and boxed in units of 10. The larger 6B handle is supplied individually in plastic wallets. Standard surgical blades in carbon steel (sterile or non-sterile) or in stainless steel (sterile). Boxed in 100's (sterile blades individually foil-wrapped; non-sterile sealed in foil packs of 5). Non-sterile blades also available individually packed in peel-open packets, boxed in 100's. Sabre E/11 and D/15 blades are produced in carbon steel only, sterile, boxed in 100's.

Standard Surgical Blades and Handles – No.4 Fitment
Surgical Blade No's 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 22A, 23, 24, 25, 25A, 26, 27, 36 fit No's 4, 4L and 6 handles. All handles are available in Stainless Steel, individually wrapped, and boxed in units of 10. The larger 6B handle is supplied individually in plastic wallets. Standard surgical blades in carbon steel (sterile or non-sterile) or in stainless steel (sterile). Boxed in 100's (sterile blades individually foil-wrapped; non-sterile sealed in foil packs of 5). Non-sterile blades also available individually packed in peel-open packets, boxed in 100's. Sabre E/11 and D/15 blades are produced in carbon steel only, sterile, boxed in 100's.

Cygnetic® Surgical Blades and Handles
For use within rigorous Orthopaedic and General surgical procedures. Cygnetic® provides the surgeon with additional strength and stability through the patented combination of its specially designed blade and handle. Handles are available in Stainless Steel, Non-Sterile, individually sleeved. Blades shapes 10,11,15 and 20 in Stainless Steel, Sterile, individually V.P.I. protected in Metal Foil Packets and boxed in units of 50.

PM40 and PM40B Post Mortem knife and Disposable Scalpels
A Post Mortem knife with a choice of two heavy duty carbon steel blades, the pointed PM40 or bull nosed PM40B. Screw type fitting to a stainless steel handle or complete as a convenient disposable scalpel with a protective guard. Spare blades are individually wrapped and boxed in 10's whilst the scalpels are available in units of 50 and 100.

Post-Mortem PM8 Handle & PM60 and PM60B Blades
Further extending the Post Mortem range, the pointed PM60 and bull nosed PM60B blades offer the ease of attaching to a PM8 handle in a traditional manner. Both blades VPI protected in single-peel packets, boxed in 50's. Handles supplied individually in plastic wallets.

Stitch Cutters
Requiring no handles, the standard stitch cutter is in carbon steel, the midi and long versions in stainless steel. The No 3 stainless steel stitch cutter can be used in conjunction with a No 3 handle for more aseptic techniques. Available individually foil-wrapped in sterile packs of 100.

Sterilisation is by Gamma Radiation (minimum dosage 25kGy, 2.5 M. Rad) carried out under strict laboratory control in Swann-Morton (Services) Ltd's Cobalt 60 continuous irradiation plant.
